WHO PROVIDES EMPLOYMENT SERVICES?

Philadelphia Corporation for Aging (PCA) funds employment services for older adults. This assistance for mature job seekers is available through the Mayor's Commission on Aging and JEVS Human Services.

The Mayor's Commission on Aging

serves Philadelphia residents 55 and older. Employment services include:

- Federally subsidized, part-time training positions in community service agencies for income-eligible applicants
- Job counseling and job search assistance
- Referrals to full- and part-time jobs
- Referrals to training programs designed for older workers
